## Summary:

- We support land use alternative 2 as it supports strategic infrastructure improvements over time
  - Feedback on the Evaluation Criteria: How will alternative 2 best deliver the objectives set out in the low carbon pathway (LCP) for the Durham Community Energy Plan (DCEP) within Oshawa?
- Feedback on the Draft Urban Design Plan and Implementation Guidelines:
  - How will the parks/green spaces be protected throughout construction?
  - We encourage the planting of native species within green spaces, when replacing trees.

## **Overview:**

- The MTSA study working group deliberated on the three land use alternatives and came to selecting alternative 2 upon the following justification:
  - Information utilized in the summary retrieved from the MTSA study webpage Land Use Alternatives PDF - slide 2, point 4: "Alternative 2 provides more distributed density that supports strategic infrastructure improvements over time"
- The three land use alternatives do not mention how the different designs would impact the short/long term carbon emissions for the area, thus prompting the working group with feedback on their evaluation criteria.
