The city has increased the security – which has helped to some degree. However, we would like a nice place that the seniors can feel very comfortable walking their dogs out back and be able to use the deck and not feel frightened.

As a non-profit building we are requesting funding to put a gate and fence up around the back of the building, so they feel more comfortable.
