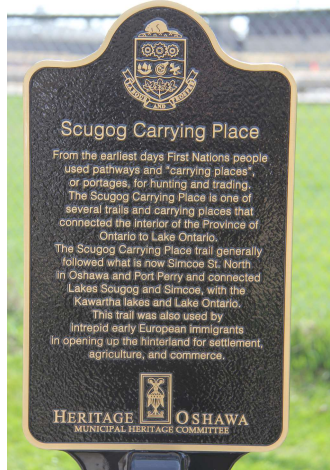
HERITAGE OSHAWA CELEBRATES OSHAWA'S 100TH

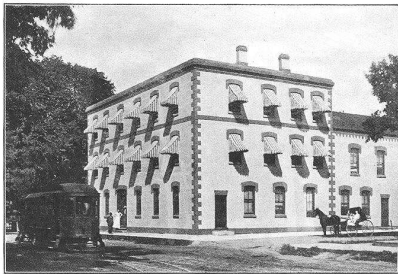
Robson Tannery now home to the Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority (CLOCA)



The Scugog Carrying Place. Trails used by our First Nations & now used by hikers.



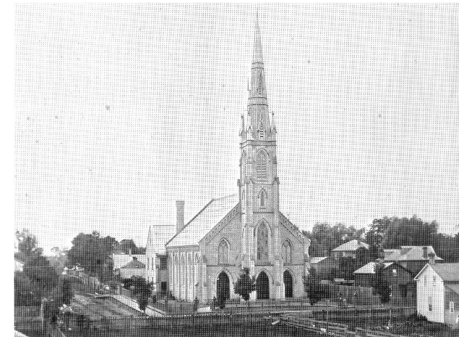
The Genosha Hotel now 70 King St East home to businesses & residences
