On behalf of the Greater Oshawa Chamber of Commerce and Oshawa Tourism, I write to convey our deepest appreciation for your generous contribution to the inaugural 2023 Convergence Music Arts & Culture Festival. Your support was instrumental in making the event a resounding success. In light of the forthcoming budgetary discussions within the City Council, we wish to present some preliminary data and insights regarding the festival's significant impact on our community.

As we await more comprehensive reporting data for the 2023 Convergence Festival, we are pleased to share early statistics. Preliminary data, sourced from Environics, indicates that the festival attracted over 6,000 visitors, with an impressive 11.3% of these attendees opting for overnight stays in Oshawa. The economic impact of this event has been substantial, with the Ontario Ministry of Tourism, Culture & Sports' "TREIM" modeling calculator, a recognized standard for evaluating the Return on Investment (ROI) of such initiatives, estimating that the City's year one investment yielded an economic impact of \$621,685 in total attendee spending. Your support was instrumental in achieving this remarkable outcome, and we are profoundly grateful for your commitment to our shared vision.

As we cast our gaze towards the 2024 Convergence Music Arts & Culture Festival, we aim to build upon the solid foundation laid in 2023. In collaboration with the City of Oshawa, in conjunction with support from various federal and provincial entities, as well as the invaluable sponsorship from the business community, we are setting our sights on an anticipated attendance figure of 15,000 visitors. The projected economic impact stands at a remarkable \$1,554,214, as assessed using the same "TREIM" modeling calculator. Your partnership in this endeavor is pivotal to the realization of these ambitious objectives, ensuring the festival's long-term vitality. To bring this vision to life for 2024, we are asking for the City of Oshawa's partnership in the form of \$100,000 in cash, coupled with a waiving of fees and the addition of in-kind supports similar to the 2023 agreement where we received the outstanding support of countless City employees, making the production feel like a true partnership.

Once again, we extend our profound gratitude for your support and consideration. We are keenly aware of the importance of transparency and accountability in matters of public funding. Rest assured, a comprehensive ROI report from the 2023 Convergence Festival will be made available in the coming weeks.
