Re: Municipal Heritage Committee Training Session provided by the Ontario

The Ontario Ministry of Citizenship and Multiculturalism has offered to provide training to municipal heritage committees, at no cost, on a variety of topics related to the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18 (the "Ontario Heritage Act") including:
