



By-law 60-2025
of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa

Being a By-law to further amend By-law 78-91, as amended (the “Skateboards and Bicycles By-law”) of the Corporation of the City of Oshawa.

Whereas Sections 11(2) and 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes a Council of a lower tier municipality to pass by-laws related to the health, safety and well-being of persons, highways, including parking and traffic on highways, and parking, except on highways; and,

Whereas the Skateboards and Bicycles By-law 78-91, as amended (“Skateboards and Bicycles By-law 78-91”) contemplate penalties against Shared E-mobility vendors whose devices may cause an obstruction; and,

Whereas in accordance with Council direction in Report [ED-25-14](#) dated January 8, 2025, regarding the E-mobility Pilot Program for enhanced parking restrictions which included the requirement for vendors to address concerns staff may be deployed to remove and impound the device including the issuance of a fine; and,

Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa considers it appropriate to amend the Skateboard and Bicycles By-law 78-91 by including a new definition of “Person” in order to allow for the ability to issue penalties to companies providing scooters, skateboards, bicycles and similar devices in the City of Oshawa; and,

Whereas pursuant to Report CO-25-21 dated May 12, 2025, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Oshawa directed that an amending by-law be passed to effectively issue penalties against Micromobility Service Providers of the City’s Shared E-mobility Program for the improper parking of “Electric Kick Scooters” on the sidewalk; and,

Therefore it is enacted as a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa as follows:

1. The Skateboards and Bicycles By-law 78-91, as amended, is amended by adding a new definition after 1.(j)., which shall now read as follows:
 - (j.1) “PERSON” means an individual, a sole proprietorship, a partnership, an unincorporated association, a trust, a body corporate or a natural person.
“Persons” has a corresponding meaning.”
