



**By-law 77-2025
of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa**

Being a by-law to amend appoint a Livestock Valuer and provide for their remuneration.

Whereas every municipality is required under the Protection of Livestock and Poultry from Dogs Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.L.24, to appoint one or more persons as valuers of livestock and poultry who shall also perform the duties of the municipal investigator under the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program;

Therefore it is enacted as a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa as follows:

1. That Brad Found be appointed the Livestock Valuer for the City of Oshawa for at term commencing June 1, 2025, and expiring on November 14, 2026, subject to holding office until his successor is appointed by City Council.
2. That the fee paid to the Livestock Valuer for their services in the City of Oshawa shall be \$100.00 per visit, plus mileage calculated at the staff rate.
3. That By-law 17-2025 is repealed.
