

Being a by-law to further amend Election Sign By-law 42-2014, as amended

Whereas Election Sign By-law 42-2014, as amended (“Election Sign By-law 42-2014”) sets out requirements and restrictions for the erection, placement, maintenance and display of Election Signs; and,

Whereas the Election Sign By-law 42-2014 sets out one size of signs on most City or Regional Roads but permits alternative sizes of signs in some locations under certain conditions; and,

Whereas it is beneficial for candidates as well as Municipal Law Enforcement and the public to harmonize the sign size standards to be consistent throughout the City;

Therefore it is enacted as a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa as follows:

1. That the following definition be added as Part 1 (h):

““Sign Facing” means the surface on which words, numbers, pictures or motifs are displayed on any side of an Election Sign, including any border, frame or material forming an integral part of the background.”
2. That Part 3 (f) be replaced with following:

“f) the Sign Facing exceeds a maximum height of 1.2 metres or exceeds a maximum width of 1.2 metres.”
3. That Part 3 (g) be deleted.
4. That Part 4 b) be amended to remove the words “Paragraphs 3(f) and 3(g)” and replace them with the words “Paragraph 3(f)”.
