

PETITION FOR A PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK**Location: Near 394–400 Bloor Street East, Oshawa, Ontario and Bloor Parkette.**

Subject: Request for Installation of a Pedestrian Crosswalk on Bloor Street East

We, the undersigned residents and concerned citizens, respectfully petition the City of Oshawa to install a clearly marked pedestrian crosswalk near **394–400 Bloor Street East** on the North side of the Street and **The Bloor Parkette** on the South side of the street.

This section of Bloor Street East is a high-traffic area serving multiple residential buildings, local businesses, public transit stops, and community facilities. Despite the number of pedestrians who regularly cross this stretch of road, there is currently no safe or designated crossing point in the immediate area.

Our concerns include:

- **Pedestrian Safety:** People, including children, seniors, people with pets and individuals with disabilities that are forced to cross without a designated crosswalk, often in unsafe conditions.
- **Accessibility:** A crosswalk would support equitable access to transit, housing, and essential services for residents with mobility challenges.
- **Traffic Calming:** A visible crosswalk would encourage drivers to slow down and be more aware of pedestrians in the shared residential area.
- **Proactive Prevention:** We believe that taking action now can prevent future injuries or accidents on this busy road.

For these reasons, we urge the City of Oshawa to prioritize a traffic safety review and the timely installation of a pedestrian crosswalk near 394–400 Bloor Street East and Bloor Parkette.
