



**By-law -2026
of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa**

Being a by-law to further amend Election Sign By-law 42-2014, as amended

Whereas Election Sign By-law 42-2014, as amended ("Election Sign By-law 42-2014") sets out requirements and restrictions for the erection, placement, maintenance and display of Election Signs including the timeframe such signs may be displayed;

Therefore it is enacted as a by-law of The Corporation of the City of Oshawa as follows:

1. That Section 3(q) be amended to remove the words "forty-second (42nd)" and replace them with the words "twenty-fifth (25th)"
