Extreme Weather

That an 'Extreme Weather' provision, including a definition, be added to the RPO Bylaw.

The working group favours the City of Mississauga provision below.

City of Mississauga Animal Care and Control By-law: 0098-2014

Definition: "Extreme Weather" means a cold warning, heat warning or other weather warning alert issued by Environment Canada for weather in the City of Mississauga (read, Oshawa) including, but not limited to, extreme cold or hot weather, snowstorms, freezing rain, heavy rainfall, hurricanes, tornadoes and/or strong winds.

General Provisions: PART V: KEEPING OF ANIMALS

No person shall allow an animal to remain outdoors during Extreme Weather, except for brief walks or brief periods of exercise, unless the animal has access to an Animal Enclosure that will adequately protect the animal from the elements. (0230-2014, 0277-2014)
